羅文原名譚百先,1945年生於廣西。1962年,羅文隻身從廣州來港,曾經從事荔園守閘員、銀行見習生。羅文,憑著他那股熱愛音樂與舞台的動力,從組織樂隊在酒廊演唱英語流行歌曲起步,憑擔任電影幕後代唱,演繹國語時代曲初露鋒芒,藉粵語流行曲攀上高峰,辦音樂舞台劇邁向演藝新領域!

全日本歌謠選手権獎座 | 1975年 由日本Yomiuri電視台舉辦的歌唱比賽,每 星期舉辦一次,每次有五位職業歌手參加。 在十次比賽中,每次皆奪第一名者,便可 榮獲冠軍寶座。羅文是第一位奪此獎項 的非日本歌手。



Champion Award of Japan for Singers | 1975 It was a singing contest held by Yomiuri Telecasting Corporation in Japan, where was shown every week on television in Japan. There were five professional singers participating in the contest each time. Any singer who won the first in the contest for ten times would receive the Champion Award.

Roman Tam was the first non-Japanese singer who won the Champion Award in this contest.

羅文是香港粵語流行曲進入黃金時期的代表人物之一,他推動粵語流行曲的發展,把這種本土的通俗文化昇華至高藝術水平的努力,是功不可沒的。羅文在1970年代的《前程錦繡》及《小李飛刀》等歌曲,令粵語流行曲在香港流行音樂文化中奠下重要位置;他以概念主題推出唱片,將創作粵語流行曲推向專業化。此外,羅文經常與各地的交響樂團合作,嘗試把粵語流行曲推上藝術欣賞的文化層次,這種推動文化融匯、交流的貢獻,實在不容忽視。羅文又積極以歌行善,經常在香港、內地以至世界各地舉行慈善籌款演唱會,參與慈善活動,造福社會。

Roman came to Hong Kong from Guangzhou on his own in 1962. He found employment as a gatekeeper at the Lai Chi Kok Amusement Park and then a bank clerk. With his passion and determination for music and the stage, Roman formed a band to perform English pop songs in bars and lounges. He progressed to being a backstage singer for local films, where he attracted attention for his vocal skills in his interpretations of Mandarin songs and reached the height of his career with Cantopop. His artistic talents then extended to the musical stage!

Roman was a symbolic figure as Cantopop entered its golden era: he was a key driver in the development of the genre and invested tireless efforts in raising this local and shared cultural form to a higher level. The songs that Roman performed, such as *Bright Future* and *The Romantic Swordsman* from the 1970s, were seminal in establishing the standing of Cantopop in Hong Kong's music culture, while his release of concept albums created the art of specialisation in the genre. What's more, Roman worked with a number of different orchestras around the world, trying to elevate the genre to a level that demanded appreciation as an art. His dedication to merging different cultures was phenomenal. Roman was also an active philanthropist, performing at charity fundraising concerts in Hong Kong, on the mainland and other locations around the world as his way of giving back to society. The countless awards he received serve as testimony

to the significant contribution he made both to the performing arts and to the community. Roman was named one of the "Ten Outstanding Young Persons" in 1983, while in 1988 he was honoured with the "Singer of the Year (Pop Group) Award" from the Hong Kong Artists' Guild at their first "Artists of the Year Awards".

Hong Kong's pop music culture has constantly flowed and changed over the past three decades, but Roman was a courageous figure who, was always able to stay ahead of his time and who never stopped innovating and leading. Roman's sonorous voice, crisp pronunciation, unworldly singing techniques, multi-styled stage looks and charismatic dance moves remain timeless icons in Hong Kong's pop music culture even in this day and age. "Roman Tam" was a name synonymous to a true talent in the hall of fame!
